

WHERE OUR MONEY GOES

In June 2014 the MPWC changed its charity giving process. It will no longer contribute to other 501(c)(3) and/or third party organizations.

Our charitable dollars will now be used directly to fund our own charitable projects that include:

Blessings in a Backpack (BIB)

Our club feeds approx.145 students per year who would otherwise have little or nothing to eat on the weekends.

Charles E. Bennett (CEB) Elementary School

We provide back-to-school clothing and shoes (Fall 2014: 35 children; Spring 2015: 40 children), holiday gifts and food gift cards (Dec 2014: 54 children) plus emergency nursing supplies throughout the year for needy students and their families.

Green Cove Springs Junior High School and Bannerman School

In addition to providing weekend food for junior high school students in need, we provide students additional emergency assistance throughout the year.

Clay High School Scholarships

Each year we celebrate the accomplishments of high school women graduates with scholarships. This spring we awarded 7 deserving senior women scholarships to total \$10,500.

In addition, our charitable dollars are used to fund emergency situations that arise during the year.

We will continue to support other 501(c)(3) organizations through volunteerism and product drives.
