In June 2014, the MPWC changed its charity giving process. Except in emergency situations, we no longer contribute to other 501(c)(3) charities. We continue to support those organizations through volunteerism and product drives. Our charitable projects that include:

### **Maggie's Meals (formerly known as Blessings in a Backpack)**

Our club feeds is currently feeding 159 students each week who would otherwise have little or no food to eat on the weekends.

### **Charles E. Bennett (CEB) Elementary School**

We provide back-to-school clothing and shoes, holiday gifts and food gift cards plus we fund emergency needs throughout the year for students and their families.

### **Green Cove Springs Junior High School and Bannerman School**

In addition to providing weekend food for junior high school students in need, we provide students additional emergency assistance throughout the year.

### **Clay High School Scholarships**

Each year we celebrate the accomplishments of high school women graduates with scholarships. In May 2017, we awarded 10 deserving senior girls scholarships that totaled \$10,000.
