## **Description of Volunteer Jobs:**

1. **Maggie's Meals** - Teams of four members pack food two or three times a year on a Friday between 9am-10:30am. The bags of food feed a hungry student over the weekend and one for each sibling at home. Team members and subs are needed. The packing schedule is made in August, so new members can participate as a substitute until the next year.
2. **Charles E. Bennett Elementary School** - More than 90% of the students live below the poverty level. Our residents have financially assisted the children for over 20 years. The women's club needs shoppers to purchase back to school clothing and Christmas gifts. We provide the information needed for shopping (gender, age, size, favorites, etc.); members make the purchases and are reimbursed by the women's club. Back to school shopping is in early September and Christmas shopping is late November, early December.
3. **Fundraising Projects** - These vary from year to year and are mostly short term volunteer jobs.
4. **Helping Hands** - Volunteers assist members and their families in times of need - illness and death. Assistance could include providing meals, driving to appointments, rehab, etc.
5. **Holiday Boutique** - A major fund raising event in the fall (usually November) and there are many areas that need volunteer assistance in pre-planning and the day of the event.
6. **Luminaries** - A major fund raising event in December where we sell luminary kits to residents to be lit typically on the second Saturday night in December. 100% of the proceeds benefit our scholarship fund. Members are needed as "block captains" who sell kits to neighbors, process orders and deliver kits when ready. The time frame for this job runs mid-November through mid-December.
