The Campbell's labels (including soup) and the "Box Tops for Education" that we collect provide "free money" to the Charles E. Bennett Elementary School.

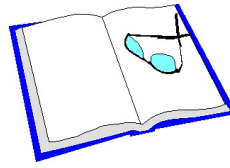
