Bring your money for a chance to win a Night at the Orange Park Community Theater which will have a presentation of the musical "White Christmas."

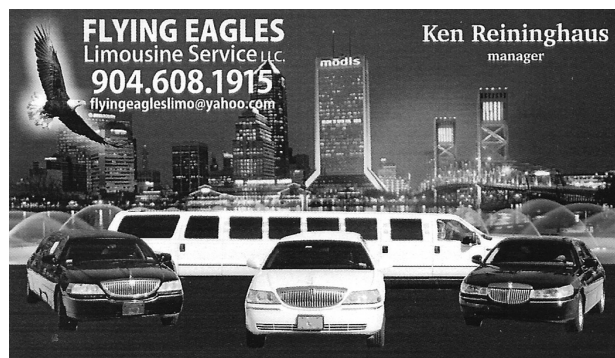
