Marline Jacobs has been doing a great job greeting our new residents and we hope they will eventually become members of our Women's Club. The more the merrier.

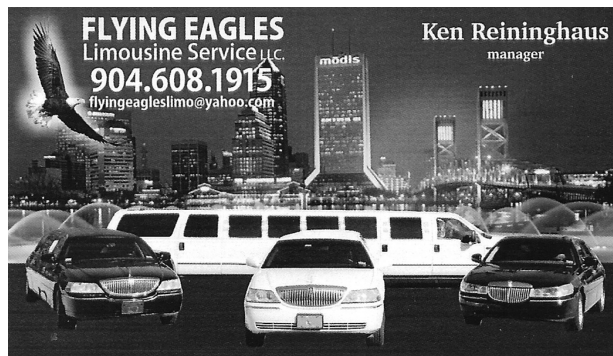
Please attend our next meeting Wednesday; we have a great program planned by Mary Kendall. It's a good way to keep informed of all the happenings and socialize with your friends.
