I know I'm leaving someone out that I need to thank. Please forgive me and consider this one big thank you.

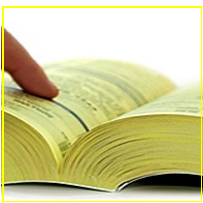
I know we will continue being a major player in this New Year making a tremendous impact for those in need.
