Below is a recap of items addressed at the 7/6/22 Board Meeting.

- The 2022-23 MPWC Budget proposed by the Finance Committee led by Linda Werring was approved unanimously.
- As of 7/6/22, MPWC has 199 members who have paid their dues garnering \$6,145.
- MPWC purchased Orange Park Theater tickets at \$250 for the upcoming year.
- MPWC donated \$20 to the GCS Garden Club.
- MPWC purchased a golf sponsorship with Clay Education Foundation for \$250.
- A unanimous vote gave Waste Not Want Not \$500 for maintenance of their equipment and gasoline for their vans.
- New club printer will be purchased; the old one will be donated to Clay County Rescue Mission.
