## \*\*\* BOARD HIGHLIGHTS –May 2025\*\*\* Magnolia Point Women's Club (MPWC)

- President Habing, Pam Young and Adele Murphy will be attending the Spring Dance Recital of the Augusta Savage Museum & Mentoring Center on May 8, 2025, at the Village Improvement Association.
- Treasurer, Linda Werring, reported:
  - Three Scholarship checks totaling \$12,000 have been issued.
  - o There are 61 members signed up for the Installation Luncheon.
  - o The MPWC Annual Report has been filed with the state of Florida with a filing fee of \$61.25.
  - o The \$180 annual hosting fee for the MPWC website has been processed.
  - The Finance Committee has met and prepared a preliminary 2025/26 budget, which will be formally presented at the June Board meeting.
  - The proposed \$5 increase in membership dues (from \$35 to \$40) was discussed. With 180 members, the increase would generate an additional \$900 available for deposits or other expenses for the upcoming MPWC 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration. In addition, the Finance Committee recommended designating \$1,000 from the unrestricted account to be used for the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event.
- Vice President Young presented the 2025/26 MPWC Slate of Officers. All Board positions have nominees in
  place; however, there are still several Director and Chair positions tentatively available. She also reported that the
  MPWC inventory has been completed.
- The Board voted to include the Magnolia Point Community Association (MPCA) Architectural Review Committee's (ARC) Requirements and Procedures document in the new resident Hospitality packets given out by MPWC.
- The Clay High School scholarship recipients have been selected, and they will be introduced at the June general meeting. The recipients were Gloriannie Sanchez Morales, Loren Westfall and Cameron Royal. These three seniors received scholarships in the amount of \$5,000, \$4,000, and \$3,000, respectively, for a total of \$12,000.
- Communications Director Sandy Waldrup presented her idea for a trivia contest based on the MPWC article in this month's *Magnolia News* to be held at the Installation Luncheon.
- Directory Ads Chair Lorna Broughton reported that the current amount collected for ads do far is \$3,060.
- President Habing announced that a membership photo will be taken outside by Dave Petraglia at about 11:45 the end of the General meeting and just before lunch is served.
- President Habing will pass around a sign-up sheet during the May General Meeting and Luncheon to recruit members to participate in the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Ad Hoc Planning Committee.
